ICD-10-CM codes (2016 to 2017): Dx T40.5; a 5th/6th character of 1-unintentional, 2-intentional self-harm, 3-assault, or 4-undetermined intent; a 7th character of A-initial encounter, D-subsequent encounter, or missing.

ICD-9-CM codes (2008 to 2014): ICD-9-CM codes under review.
